

Home-stay Guidelines:

These guidelines help to ensure that SDRC host members are responsible hosts and reduce the risk of students from other schools having problems while they are guests.



As hosts SDRC students and their parents are to:

- Personally observe any curfew times that are set, and demand visiting players to follow these times as well.
- Remind students to follow the no drug, tobacco, and alcohol policies of SDRC.
- Refrain from taking students from other schools to places where drinking is encouraged.
- Ensure that the students arrive at the school/venue at the time designated by their Coaches/Directors.
- Coaches will call all SDRC participants from each of their schools each night of the event.
- Provide visiting students with breakfast and evening meal. Hosts are welcome to share other meals/snacks if they wish.
- SDRC home-stays may only be changed to cater to emergency situations. The Tournament or Event Director should make such changes.
- One parent or legal guardian must reside in the house during a home-stay.
